About the ACL Gateway

The ACL Gateway aims to provide a one-stop shop solution for the everyday needs of learners, tutors and staff for collaboration, learning, sharing and working. It is available online and can be accessed anytime, anywhere and from any device with an internet connection. It will also prove a useful tool for prospective learners to learn more about the service, enrol on courses plus more.

The ACL Gateway is the main gateway through to all online systems and services which includes; the ACL Management System, an online system for managing courses, learners, enrolments and more. A training manual will be provided for the ACL Management system at workshops and training events.

The ACL Gateway will not be a complete product at this stage because there are several more developments we are working on which are planned for release in coming weeks. These updates will ensure we have a system we can be confident in before the start of the new academic year. Please refer to the Project Update document for more information.

We will formally launch and begin using the ACL Gateway from 5th September 2016. However, there will be opportunities over the coming weeks to test out the system prior to this.



Then, sign in using your username and password.


How to Log in (Main Site)

Your username and password are assigned automatically.

Username: Your username is firstname.surname or email address

Password: Must be a minimum of 8 characters which include one special character and one numerical character

Remember Username: If ticked, this will remember you on the device.


Log in Button: Select Log in to access the site.

The Top Navigation menu is consistent throughout the site and is the main menu used to access all areas of the site.




Slideshow Menu

The Slideshow menu provides links to find a course, enrol now and visit ACL website.




Page Navigation Menu
